- **CAT/CAT Jr.**
 - CAT Jr.
 - Cleaner, simpler, more graphics, icons as buttons
 - Open for review by all librarians in early May
 - Intention was to recreate basic CAT Jr. with improvements
 - New sort and item group filter
 - New material type images on results page
 - Reading program search has ranges (not just drop downs)
 - Lexile search added
 - Can add ChiliFresh Review Engine (elementaries are free with purchase of ChiliFresh for MS & HS) (can be removed from CAT Jr...but seen in elementary Cat 2.0)
 - Availability...prior to 2010 school year
 - Waiting for all ITC to upgrade Workflows
 - Preview
 - Publisher, page number comments:
 - Keep...kids need # pages, and use for bibliography
 - Possibly not show whole Marc Record
 - Lexile, AR, summary, interest level
 - Can we put it on a link or additional tab?
 - If you don't have AR or Reading Counts, can you default to Lexile level?
 - Would like to pursue awards list (short list) customizable as to whether it appears on screen or not
 - CAT Changes (after CAT Jr. is done)
 - Mostly bug fixes and customizable options
 - Investigating adding Guided Reading
 - Fontis and Pinnell
 - 7-8 years ago some schools met with F&P who were reluctant to allow lists to be used w/o some subscription
 - F&P if in Marc can be mined for CAT
- **Curriculum Resource Catalog**
 - How do you currently use this resource?
 - Used by some (1 or 2 in room) for collection development (what other schools are using for projects)

- Members reported using ITC level search more often
 - **Electronic Resource Update**
 - State Library of Ohio renewed Core Collection for 2010-2011 = NO CUTS
 - Username / Password for 2010-2011 has been distributed
 - 2009-2010 password will work through September
 - Toolkit will be ready August 1 (although link will be live July)
 - Mobile apps
 - (SirsiDynix) BookMyne available for iPhone, iPod touch and iPad FREE APP
 - Requires OS 3.0 or later
 - Also developing for Droid and Blackberry
 - **Allows searching catalog from phone**
 - Locate libraries worldwide
 - Renew checked out items
 - Place & cancel holds
 - Check account details
 - iPhone GPS identifies libraries within range of miles
 - can limit what libraries you see
 - is limited to SirsiDynix libraries
 - Will require some INFOhio setup
 - Also possibility of staff level app to do circulation from phone
 - BioRef Bank will have app in fall
 - World Book 6 mos+ out in development
 - EBSCO has mobile site usable through app

 - **Discovery Tools (SchoolRooms, Federated searching, etc)**
 - **SchoolRooms—new platform**
 - Will now run on Enterprise platform
 - Paradigm shift for use of product
 - Rooms content can be managed differently
 - Can be modified by INFOhio directly
 - Can change link or federation with catalog
 - Federated Searches can be modified
 - New features
 - Can now search content
 - Content enrichment
 - Can add local content
 - WHO MANAGES?
 - SHOULD IT BE PEER REVIEWED?
 - Faceted searching (# hits by author or type)
 - Can be purchased at building level
 - Federated Searching—interest?
 - Widget vs. Federated search?
 - Integrated Card Catalog
 - Prime feature, please keep
 - **Podcasts in the union catalog or in your catalog**
 - Book Reviews
 - OPAC has review engine from ChiliFresh

- INFOhio will host student/librarian produced podcasts of book reviews
 - ITSCO service area has been creating podcasts with LSTA grant
 - These will be used
 - Podcasts linked in 856 tag
 - Worth pursuing ability to access these
