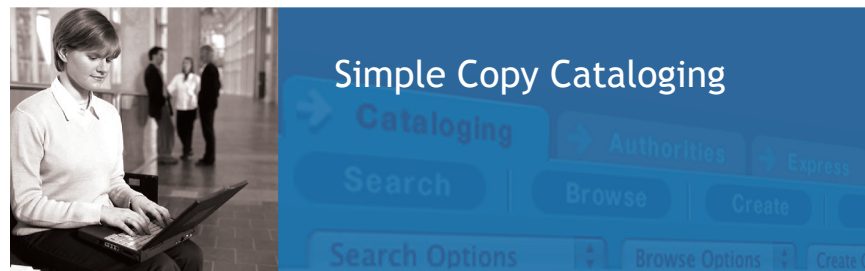

## CatExpress

### Who Can Participate

- Public and private K-12 schools
- Libraries automated with any automation system

Once you subscribe, all you need to use CatExpress is access to the World Wide Web and a current generation Web browser like Netscape Navigator 7.0 and above or Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.5 and above.

### How CatExpress works

- Log into your OCLC CatExpress account.
- Search and export records that match the item being cataloged.
- If automated via a DASite with INFOhio, records appear in the school catalog the following day.
- If automated via a stand alone system, export records from the INFOhio web site the following day.

### Cost of CatExpress Service

- \$100 per 100 records
- Records must be purchased in blocks of 100.
- Blocks can be shared by all libraries within a district
- DASites can consolidate orders for those requiring fewer than 100 records.
