

# Linking Britannica Video Clips to PowerPoint Presentations

This method works from any of the Britannica encyclopedias and *Annals of American History*. In addition to *PowerPoint*, this method also works in *Word* and in EBSCO's *Page Composer*.

## EASY METHOD

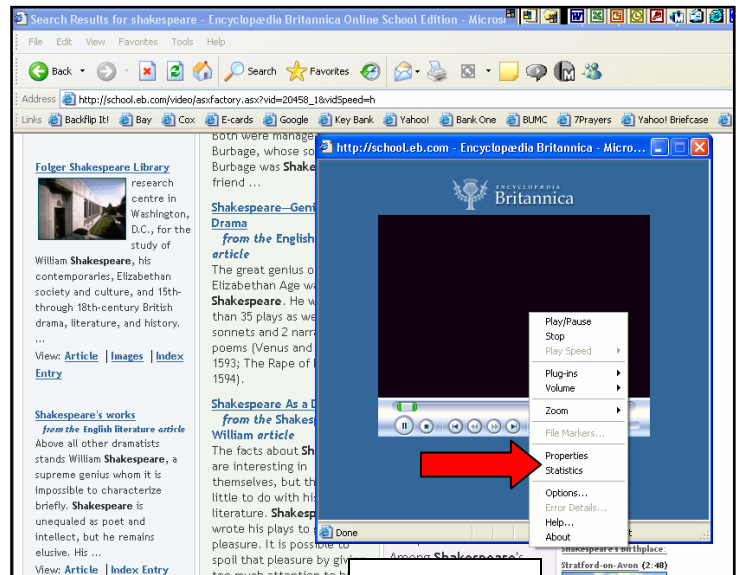
Display the hyperlink URL

1. Locate the clip you want to add and click on the link to begin playing it.

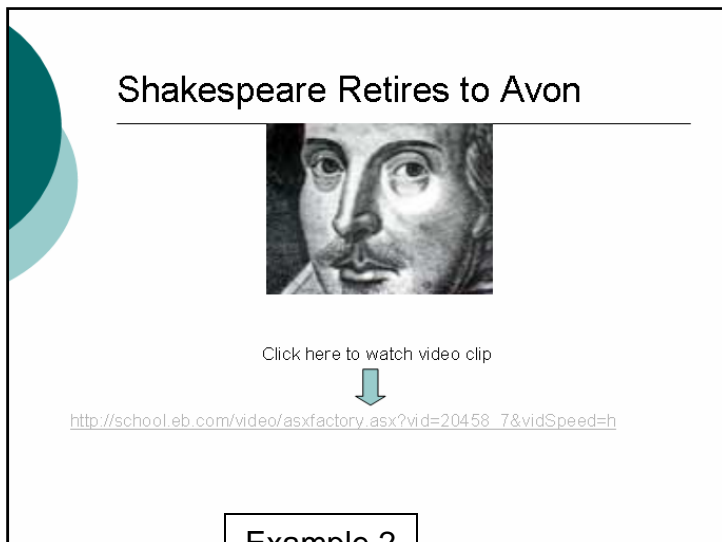
2. Right-mouse-click over top of the video and select *Properties*. (Example 1)

3. Highlight and copy the URL under *Properties* to the clipboard.

4. Paste the URL of the video clip as text onto the *PowerPoint* slide. (Example 2)

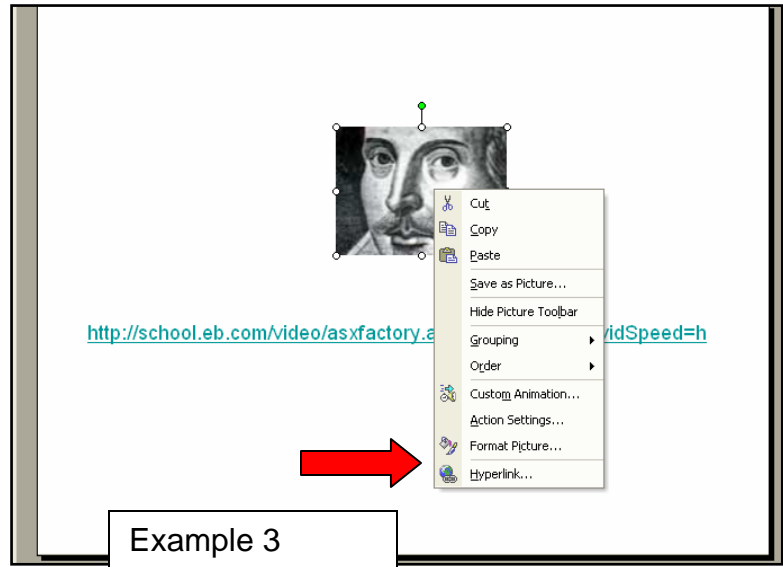

## ALTERNATIVE METHOD

Hyperlink directly to an image or graphic.

1. As described above, paste the URL of the video clip onto the PowerPoint slide.
2. Select a graphic or word to hyperlink.
3. Right-mouse-click on the item to be linked and select *Hyperlink*. (Example 3)



4. Carefully type the URL you have already pasted on the slide into the Hyperlink box.
5. If you have selected the graphic illustrating the video clip, it will already include a hyperlink, which you can *Edit*. The number of the video will already be included and you will just need to add text before and after. (Example 4)
