America's Newspapers (NewsBank)

1. A high school senior is curious to find some information about the concealed weapons law in Ohio.

www.infohio.org -> Core Collection -> NewsBank Newspapers

Select "Ohio Titles"



Type the search term "concealed weapon law" NOTE: The default return is "Most Recent Matches First". The default timeframe is "all years"



Here are the results...

Note: It is not necessary to check any of the boxes to search ALL the indexed Ohio papers. The database defaults to search ALL the newspapers listed.

2. The coaching staff has heard about a new "sport" called Geocaching. They'd like to know if there has been anything reported about it in Ohio.

www.infohio.org -> Core Collection -> NewsBank Newspapers -> Select "Ohio Titles" -> Search Term: Geocaching

a. Now run the search by switching from "most recent matches first" to "Best matches first"

5. The senior class president would like to read some recent articles about the proposed cell phone ban in Akron.

www.infohio.org -> Core Collection -> NewsBank Newspapers -> Select "Ohio Titles" -> Select: Advanced Search -> Select: Akron Beacon Journal -> Search Term: schools (in all text) and "cell phone" (in all text) -> Select: "Best matches first" -> Select Timeframe: Past twelve months -> Search

6. Are there articles about cell phone bans in schools in other Ohio papers?

www.infohio.org -> Core Collection -> NewsBank Newspapers -> Select "Ohio Titles" -> Select: Advanced Search -> Search Term: schools (in all text) and "cell phone" (in all text) -> Select: "Best matches first" -> Select Timeframe: Last twelve months -> Search

7. The social studies teacher would like his students to have access to the past 5 days of newspapers from a large city and a small town. Can you help?

www.infohio.org -> Core Collection -> NewsBank Newspapers -> Select "Ohio Titles" -> Select: Dayton Daily News -> Select: The date you want

8. Now the teacher would like to know if there is any way to view a specific span of dates in specific Ohio newspapers. For example, press coverage following Hurricane Katrina.

www.infohio.org -> Core Collection -> NewsBank Newspapers -> Select "National Titles" -> Search Term: "hurricane Katrina" -> Select Custom Date: Sep 1, 2005 – Dec 31, 2005

13. What was the coverage like following Hurricane Katrina in the Miami Herald?
