As of July 1, 2002, INFOhio provides Ohio's K-12 community with a comprehensive package of online full-text periodicals and other resources from EBSCO Information Services.

EBSCOhost offers a wide variety of reference and literacy resources for students and teachers in K-12 schools. These web-based products

combine user-friendly interfaces with quality full text content from popular magazines, education journals, newspapers, primary source documents, biographies, almanacs, dictionaries, encyclopedias, and other reference sources valuable to today's schools. This package replaces the previous INFOhio ProQuest Collection.

Great for High Schools...

Comprehensive databases designed specifically for high schools, contain full text for nearly 500 popular high school magazines including *Careers & Colleges*, *Popular Science*, *Smithsonian*, *Bioscience*, *American History*, *Jet*, *Newsweek*, etc. Also available are 88,000 biographies and 60,000 primary source documents. These databases also provide nearly 150 reference books online (including the *Columbia Encyclopedia*, the *CIA World Fact Book* and *Lovejoy's College Guide*) and an Image Collection of 91,000 photos, maps and flags.

Great for Middle Schools...

Additional databases, specifically designed for middle schools, contain full-text for more than 140 popular middle

school magazines. Also included are biographies, historical essays, primary source documents such as Essential Documents in American History, reference books including the *Funk & Wagnall's New Encyclopedia*, *American Heritage Dictionary* and *Encyclopedia of Animals*.

Great for Elementary Schools...

Another set of databases is specifically designed for elementary schools, containing full-text for more than 50 popular magazines, *Encyclopedia of Animals*, and *American Heritage Children's Dictionary*. These resources have been selected to provide students with easy-to-read articles written specifically for kids. And the Searchasaurus® interface is an exciting, easy way for young researchers to experience online searching that encourages students to enhance and develop basic search methodologies.

Not only can teachers use all of these resources for classroom instruction with students, but they can also access the Professional Development Collection. This is a comprehensive and specialized collection of over 500 full-text high quality education journals designed for professional educators. These titles cover a wide range of topics including administration, curriculum, assessment, social issues, libraries, specific subject areas and more:

ERIC can also be searched using EBSCOhost, which provides access from ERIC citations to the full-text articles in the Professional Development Collection. And the Academic Search Premier database makes more than 3,000 scholarly, peer-reviewed journals available to both teachers and students.

And Page Composer is the fastest way for teachers to create a web page with

links directly to EBSCOhost articles. Teachers can create a class syllabus with reading exercises from articles in EBSCOhost or a reading list.

For home use students or teachers must enter a username and password the first time they access any INFOhio Electronic Resource from their home computer. Usernames and passwords for home use are distributed by the DASites.

Academic Search Premier

- Secondary Search, Professional Search

Provides full text for more than 3,430 scholarly publications covering academic areas of study including social sciences, humanities, education, computer sciences, engineering, language and linguistics, arts & literature, medical sciences, and ethnic studies. This database is updated on a daily basis.

Alt HealthWatch

This database focuses on the many perspectives of alternative medicine, complementary, holistic and integrated approaches to health care and wellness. Alt-HealthWatch offers libraries an immediate resource of full text articles from more than 170 international peer-reviewed and professional journals, magazines, reports, proceedings, association & consumer newsletters plus hundreds of pamphlets, booklets, special reports, original research and book excerpts.

Business Source Premier

Provides full text for over 2,710 scholarly business journals covering management, economics, finance, accounting, international business and much more. This database is updated on a daily basis.

Business Wire News

A full text newswire database that incorporates business wires from all over the world. Included in this database are A&G Information, Africa News Service, Inter Press Service, Resource News International, South American Business, M2 Communications, PR Newswire, Business News Wire, Canadian Corporate News, News Bytes News Network and Phillips Business Information Highlights. This database is updated on a daily basis.

Computer Source

Provides researchers with the latest information and current trends in high technology.

Ebsco Animals

-Primary Search, Middle Search

Provides in-depth information on a variety of topics relating to animals. The database consists of indexing, abstracts, and full text records describing the nature and habitat of familiar animals.

ERIC

-Professional Search

ERIC, the Educational Resource Information Center contains citations and abstracts from over 980 educational and education-related journals, as well as full text of more than 2,200 digests.

Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia

-Primary Search, Middle Search

Provides over 25,000 encyclopedic entries. Searchable by subject or keywords within the entry.

Health Source: Consumer Edition

Contains information on many health topics including the medical sciences, food sciences and nutrition, childcare, sports medicine and general health. The database features searchable full text for over 190 journals including Consumer Reports on Health and Men's Health, as well as abstracts and indexing for over 205 general health, nutrition and professional health care publications.

Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition

Provides nearly 590 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. Also featured are abstracts and indexing for over 627 journals. This database is updated on a daily basis.

MAS Ultra: School Edition

-Secondary Search

Provides full text for 460 general interest and current events magazines.

MasterFILE Premier

-Secondary Search (default for Secondary Search)

Provides full text for over 1,900 periodicals covering nearly all subjects including general reference, business, health, and much more.

MEDLINE

Provides authoritative medical information on medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system, pre-clinical sciences, and much more. Created by the National Library of Medicine, MEDLINE allows users to search abstracts from over 4,600 current biomedical journals.

Middle Search Plus

-Primary Search, Middle Search (default for Middle Search)

Provides full text for over 140 magazines covering general topics appropriate for middle and junior high school students.

Newspaper Source

-Secondary Search

Provides full text for 245 regional U.S. newspapers, eighteen international newspapers, six newswires, and nine newspaper columns, The Christian Science Monitor, and The Los Angeles Times (for a total of 194 full text newspapers and other sources).

Primary Search

-Primary Search

Provides full text for 50 children's magazines and over 100 children's pamphlets, designed for the elementary school student.

Professional Development Collection

-Professional Search (default for Professional Search)

Provides a highly specialized collection of over 500 full text journals, designed for professional educators.

Psychology and Behavioral Sciences Collection

A comprehensive database with more than 510 full text titles covering topics such as emotional and behavioral characteristics, psychiatry & psychology, mental processes, anthropology, and observational and experimental methods.

Religion and Philosophy Collection

A database with over 290 full text journals and unparalleled coverage of such topics as world religions, major denominations, biblical studies, religious history, epistemology, political philosophy, philosophy of language, moral philosophy and the history of philosophy.

Sociological Collection

A comprehensive database with nearly 580 full text titles that provides information on all areas of sociology, including social behavior, human tendencies, interaction, relationships, community development, culture and social structure.

USP DI Volume II, Advice for the Patient

Provides patient-oriented drug information in lay language. Monographs are organized into the following sections: Brand Names commonly used in both the United States and Canada, Description, Before Using This Medicine, Proper Use of This Medicine, Precautions, and Side Effects.

-Middle Search, Secondary Search

Designed for vocational and technical libraries servicing high schools, community colleges, trade institutions and public libraries. The collection provides full text coverage for 350 trade and industry related periodicals.
