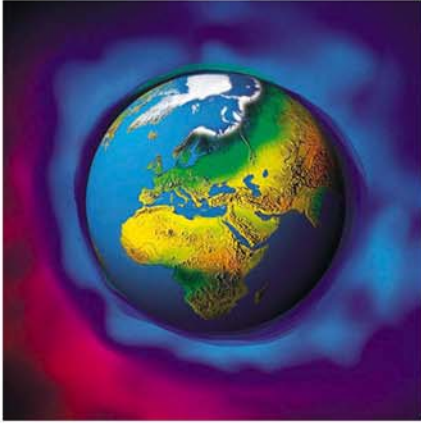


The April-May edition of SchoolRooms has wonderful resources that cover the scope of the curriculum, as well as seasonal topics like National Poetry Month and Earth Day.
