



## INFOhio Back to School Teacher Checklist 2002-2003

- Are the **INFOhio username/password bookmarks** for home access copied and ready to be given to every student in your classroom? (See your library media specialist for copies.)
- Have you downloaded the **EBSCOhost Resource Flyer** from the INFOhio Web site to help with an overview of the resources provided through INFOhio?

- Have you explored other helpful sites linked from the INFOhio Web site (e.g., **NetWellness**, **Ohio Government Information**, **Ohio Bicentennial**, **Ohio Resource Center**, and **Ohio Memory Project**)?
- Have you visited **OH! Teach** recently to see what Web resources are available to help plan lessons and support your instruction? OH! Teach has its own button near the top of the INFOhio home page.
- Have you urged your students to get an Ohio public library card? Do you have an Ohio public library card?
