

Ohio's Area Media Centers are now offering digital videos for statewide use to all Ohio students and educators at NO COST.

INFOhio's K-12 Curriculum Resource Catalog (CRC) has links to the videos, so they can be searched using the same interface that over 2,000 schools use to search their own school library collection. Titles, subject headings and keywords are searchable.

Ohio's Area Media Centers have secured long-term licenses from 16 well-respected video producers such as Disney, Weston Woods and Films for the Humanities and Sciences to make use convenient and reliable.

INFOhio's CRC records have hyperlinks to the full video, which can be streamed (watched live) over a high-speed Internet connection, downloaded for 45 days to the user's desktop, or borrowed on CD from your local **Area Media Center**.

Links to support materials such as teacher guides, reproducible masters for student assignments, or related web sites are included. By using **INFOhio's CRC** as the central access point for these resources, related links are always accessible and reliable.

Ohio's Area Media Centers' digital video collection can help Ohio educators by providing:

- Resources that support Ohio Academic Content Standards
- High demand and seasonal titles needed by many teachers at peak times each year

- Find the Ohio Area Media Center serving your school

Access is free but controlled by username/password to ensure use only by Ohio's K-12 community. Check the Directory here or online at:

- View the list of videos and make your selection
Sort by title or date for easier browsing
- Choose "Locate this Media title"

- Login
- "View Now" to stream the video, or "Download" to view for up to 45 days on your desktop

Tech Tips

Computer Requirements

Macintosh or Windows computers work equally well, but it is essential to have a current version of your browser.

View Now

Video streaming works best with fiber, cable or full T1 connections. Check with the school's technology coordinator to find out if there are streaming video restrictions due to the high amount of bandwidth needed.

Streaming these videos requires RealPlayer; a free download is available at <http://www.real.com/>

Download

If streaming will not work or is prohibited, temporary downloading is an option. The video can be saved to a computer - or several classroom computers - for use any time during a 45 day period.

CD-ROM

Schools unable to stream or download may borrow the videos on CD-ROM from their Area Media Center.

Downloaded video files or videos on CD may be viewed with RealPlayer, Windows MediaPlayer or QuickTime.

Copyright

Downloaded digital videos may be kept on your desktop computer only for 45 days. After 45 days, copyright requires you to download again to continue using it. You may, however, repeat the download as many times as you need it through the school year, always at no cost. It is a violation of copyright to download to a server to bypass the username/password process or to redistribute any of these video titles.
