Digital Newspaper Collections

- **Chronicling America: Historic American Newspapers** (<http://chroniclingamerica.loc.gov>)
 - Free keyword-searchable digital newspaper database containing over 7 million historic American newspaper pages (covering 1836-1922) and over 150,000 newspaper catalog records (covering 1690-Present). *More than 300,000 pages from Ohio newspapers are on this site, representing over 50 counties and over 60 titles/title families.*
 - Collaborative project of the Library of Congress and the National Endowment for the Humanities, containing content contributed by state partners.
- **Ohio Memory** (www.ohiomemory.org)
 - Free digital library containing over 400,000 digital images representing every county in the state, and ranging from prehistory to the twenty-first century. *More than 100,000 keyword-searchable Ohio newspaper pages (covering 1832-2011) are on this site.* The site also has a number of educational resources, including Featured Topics, Interactives and Video Tutorials.
 - Collaborative project of the Ohio History Connection and the State Library of Ohio, containing content from over 360 submitting institutions.
