It contains full text for more than 250 health reference books and encyclopedias including the *American Medical Association Complete Medical Encyclopedia*, *Complete Guide to Prescription & Nonprescription Drugs 2012*, *Cornell Illustrated Encyclopedia of Health*, *Mayo Clinic Family Health Book*, *Oxford Handbook of Child Nutrition*, and many more.

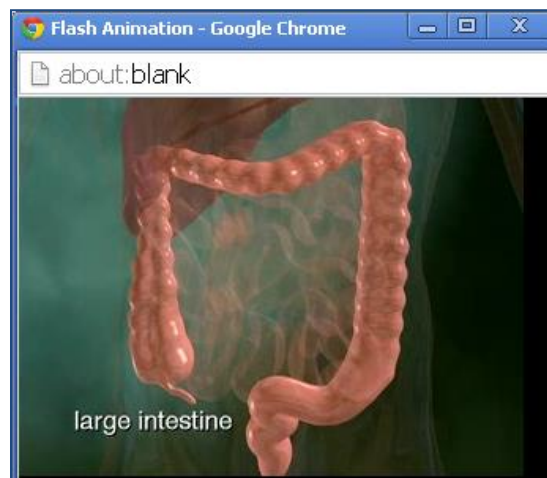
