


#### **Workflows Screen**

Sirsi K-12 features wizards that allow you to perform complex library tasks quickly and efficiently. These wizards can be accessed on toolbars. The helper bar, menu bar, and tools such as gadgets, glossaries, tabbed folders, alert windows right-click menus, and hypertext links allow you to move easily through Workflows.

#### **WorkFlows Themes**

WorkFlows Themes display a new look that is consistent with today's desktop graphical environment, and provides much faster navigation between Unicorn modules and functions.

You can change your WorkFlows desktop colors by selecting from a set of preset color palettes. To change WorkFlows Themes, from the menu bar *Click* on Preference, point to Desktop, and *Click* Desktop Setup. In the Themes box, select a theme (or color palette) from the drop-down list, and *Click* OK. The first time you may be prompted to restart the workstation to see the new theme windows.

**NOTE**: Once you are in Themes mode, you can easily change to other themes without having to restart the workstation again. **NEVER** select Classic!








# **WIZARD FONT Settings**

The font size of toolbar text (wizard names) can **be modified** using the **Font Settings** control under the **Desktop** options of the **Preference** menu.







Large font size may create "sliders" that you will need to be aware of when looking at full lists:






#### **Tabbed Windows**

Select the 'Tabbed Windows' check box to open multiple tabbed windows simultaneously in WorkFlows. Each time you open a new wizard, a new tab will display for that particular wizard.

**NOTE:** Tabs cannot be reorganized.



When you select a WorkFlows Theme the tabbed windows check box displays.

- Select the Tabbed Window check box to open multiple tabbed windows. Tabs display at the top of the client workspace by default.
- Placing a check in 'Tabbed windows on bottom' allows display of tabs at the bottom of the screen.
- 3. The selected tab open in the client workspace is the active wizard.
- 4. The active wizard's name is the only wizard name displayed in the window caption.
- 5. When a single wizard is opened multiple times, numbers will appear in the tab next to the wizard's name to distinguish between each tabbed window for that wizard.

#### Helpful Tip:

Users can switch between tabbed windows by pressing either:

CTRL + Tab or CTRL + Page Up to move to the next tabbed window

CTRL + Shift + Tab or CTRL + Page Down to move to the previous tabbed window

To close a tab, simply click on the close icon or press CTRL + W.




# Right-click menus

WorkFlows supports right-click menus for wizards and other WorkFlows functions. The right-click menus are 'popup' or shortcut menus that contain commands and options that can be performed against a selected record or group of records. The right-click menus are available using a mouse right-click in circulation lists (or tables), such as checkouts, bills, holds, and more.

Once in a right-click menu, click a circulation or print option to access that option.

**NOTE:** Not all options are available in all wizards. If a user does not have access to a wizard or wizard function, that option will not appear in the list.






# **Resizing the Screens**

Most screens in Java can be made larger or smaller by simply clicking and dragging. Watch your mouse as you move it around the screen. When it turns to resize mode (2 points), you can click and drag that section to the size you wish.


