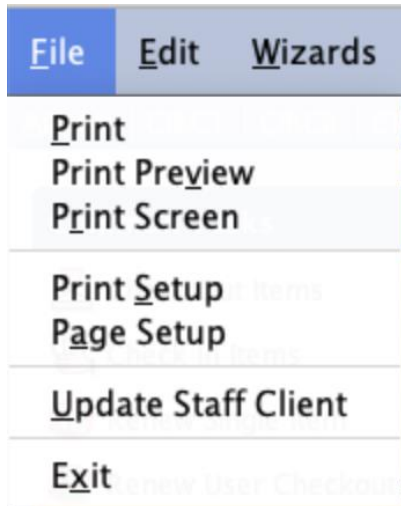


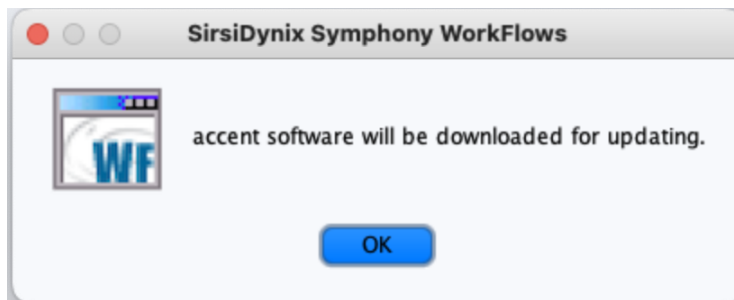
## Updating to Mac WorkFlows 4.0.0.0.1260

The initial release of Mac WorkFlows 4.0 had a bug where the override prompt was hidden behind other windows. To address the issue, a patched version of Mac WorkFlows, 4.0.0.0.1260, was made available. To install the WorkFlows Update, you will need administrative access to the computer.

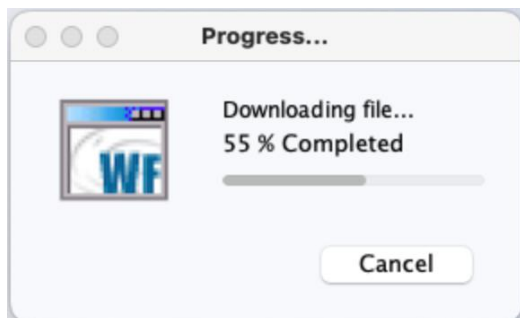
1. Start WorkFlows and login with your credentials.
2. Click on File and select Update Staff Client.



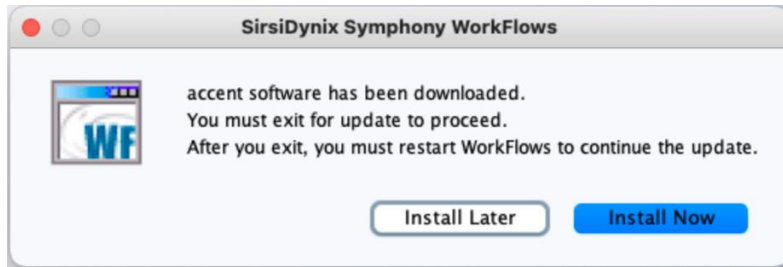
3. You will be presented with this message. Click OK.



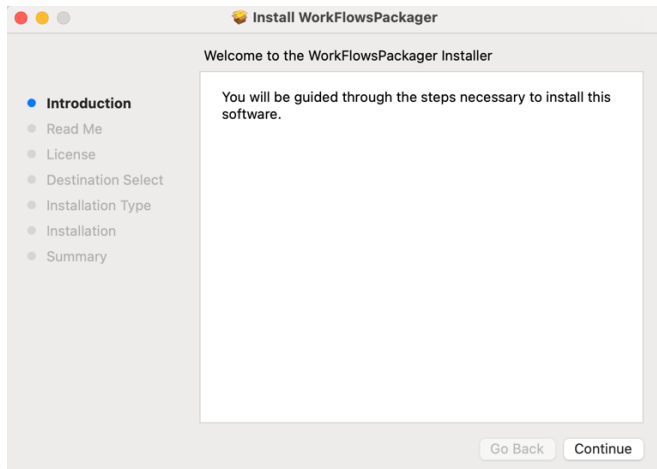
4. You will then see a screen showing that the updated software is downloading.



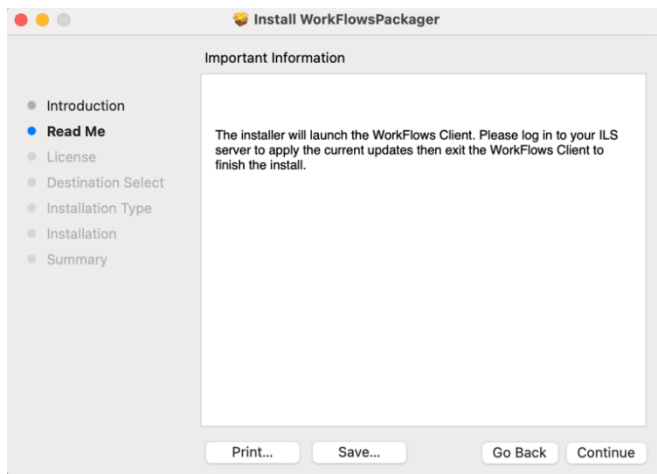
5. After the download has completed, you will be given the option to “Install Later” or “Install Now”. Select “Install Now.”



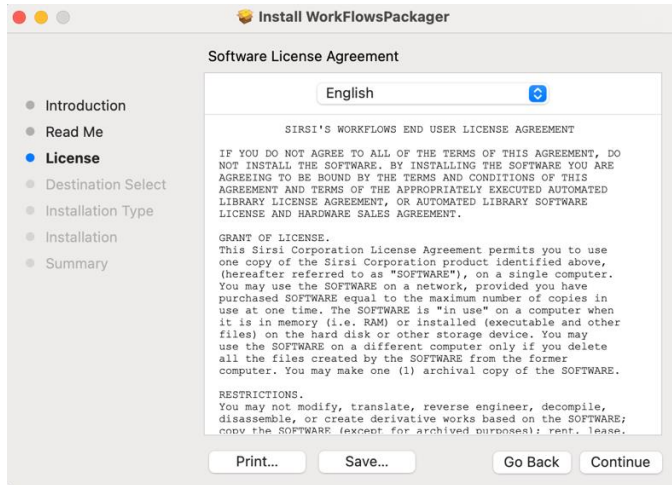
6. WorkFlows will exit.
7. Restart WorkFlows.
8. You will be presented with the following screen, click “Continue.”



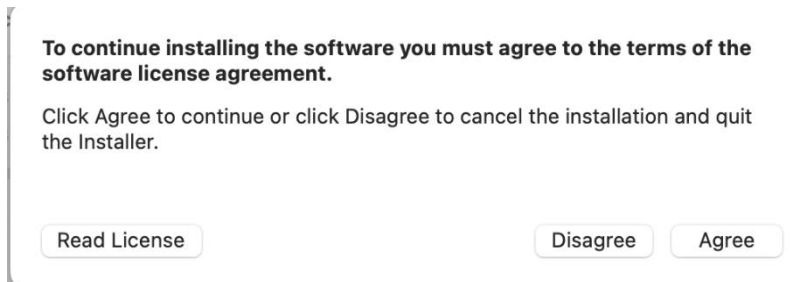
9. Click “Continue” on the next screen.



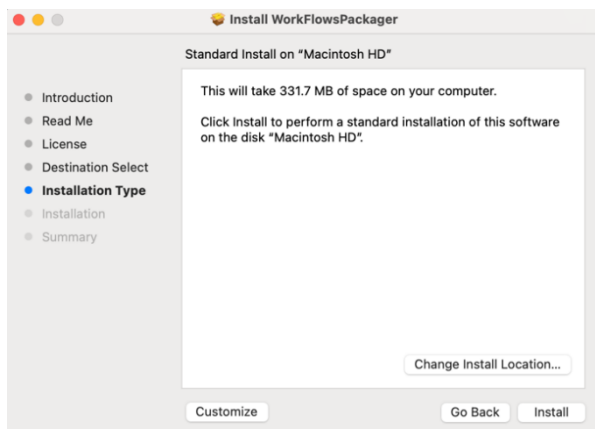
10. Click "Continue."



11. Click "Agree."



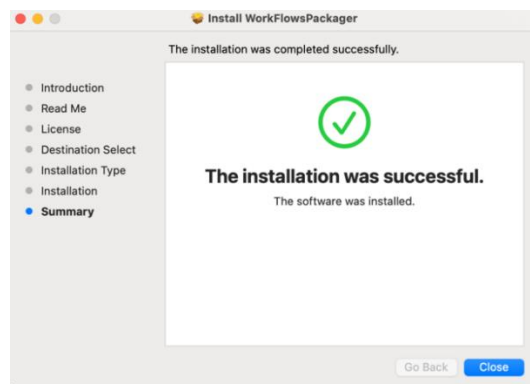
12. Click "Install."



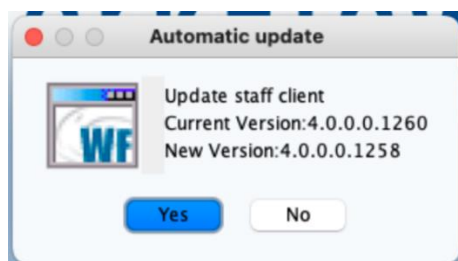
13. Enter either your computer login credentials or the credentials of someone with administrative rights for the computer. Click “Install Software”.



14. Click “Close”.



15. When starting WorkFlows, you might see this message after logging into WorkFlows. Answer “No”. You want to be using version **4.0.0.1260**. **1260** contains the patch so that the override screens appear correctly.



This message might show each time WorkFlows is started. Click “No” each time.
