Optional Training Activities

Learning Objectives

Participants in the ISearch for Librarians class will achieve the following objectives:

- Learn what ISearch is, its role in the library, and how to access.
- Explore the ISearch interface and understand which content collections are available in ISearch.
- Learn how to create a widget, bookmark, or link for ease of access.
- Create a book river to highlight collections in your library and increase use and circulation.
- Develop strong search skills using advanced search, limiters, and filters.
- Learn how to find ISearch statistics.
- Learn how to create customized access to ISearch to fit the needs of students, teachers, and parents.
- Learn what ISearch Mobile is, its role in the library, and how to access.
- Explore the ISearch Mobile interface.
- Identify best practices for using ISearch in the classroom.
- Consider methods for sharing ISearch with teachers, tech coordinators, administrators, and parents.
- Reflect on learning by sharing information with others.

In this course, participants will work through several lessons to learn more about ISearch, INFOhio's discovery search interface. Participants will learn how to use ISearch to find resources for students and how to teach students, colleagues, and parents to use ISearch. Upon successful completion of this class, participants will earn a certificate for four and a half (4.5) contact hours. Below is a description of each lesson and the amount of time it should take for participants to complete each one.



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Getting Started

Pre-test

Review the course objectives and the course overview. (5 minutes)

Optional Training Activity

• Create a "Parking Lot" for questions that arise throughout the training, either with chart paper or in a shared digital document like Google Docs. (5 minutes)

Using Open Space Groups

Lesson Content

Join the ISearch Users group in Open Space. In this group, discuss and reflect on the integration of technology with like-minded adults. (5 minutes)

Getting to Know ISearch

• Lesson Content

Learn about ISearch, what it is and what it includes. Explore the homepage and search screen. (20 minutes)

Optional Training Activities

- In small groups, participants should discuss the reflection questions and share their responses with the larger group. (10 minutes)
- Use the ISearch for Librarians Guided Notes throughout this training to help participants engage in learning. (time included in lesson)
- Answer the discussion questions from the lesson in the <u>ISearch Users</u> Open Space group. Find the *Getting to Know ISearch* post in the Discussions tab. (5 minutes)

• Do a live presentation of the information found in this lesson. Participants can follow along as you lead if they have a device. (10 minutes)

Getting the Results You Want

• Lesson Content

Develop strong search skills and strategies. Learn how applying limiters under each tab can give you better results. (15 minutes)

Optional Training Activities

- Do a live presentation of the information presented in this lesson. Participants can follow along on a device if they have access to one. (10 minutes)
- In small groups, discuss the discussion questions. Share with the larger group. (10 minutes)
- Answer the discussion questions from the lesson in the <u>ISearch Users</u> Open Space group. Find the *Getting the Results You Want* post in the Discussions tab. (5 minutes)

Saving Items

• Participants should spend time familiarizing themselves with the different tabs, how to access them, and the limiters available. Present possible search terms and have participants share how they arrived at the resource they chose. (15 minutes)

Accessing My Account from ISearch Mobile

• Lesson Content

Learn how to access and use the available My Account features within ISearch Mobile. (10 minutes)

Optional Training Activity

- Have participants practice logging into My Account. Share examples of schools that have different features, like holds or renewals, turned on. (10 minutes)
- Discuss best practices for teaching students how and when to access and use My Account.

Learn how to create customized access to ISearch. (15 minutes)

Optional Training Activity

 Participants should look at their version of ISearch and make a list of the customizations they would like to add. (10 minutes)

• Lesson Content

Learn how to use buttons and URLs to link users to ISearch from a webpage. (10 minutes)

Optional Training Activity

• Demonstrate creating a button and have participants make a plan to add a link, button or widget on their website. (15 minutes)

Embedding the ISearch Widget on a Webpage

• Lesson Content

Learn how to create a widget for easy access to ISearch from a webpage. (10 minutes)

Optional Training Activity

 Demonstrate creating a widget and have participants make a plan to add a link, button, or widget on their website. (15 minutes)

ISearch Use Data

• Lesson Content

Learn how to find ISearch statistics. (10 minutes)

Optional Training Activities

- Do a live presentation on accessing the INFOhio Resource Use Data page. Demonstrate locating statistics for a specific district. (5 minutes)
- Brainstorm ways to report your data to your Administrators. Share with the group.
