

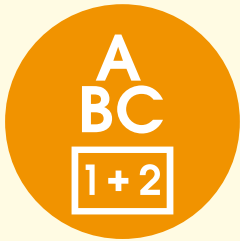

Ten Ways to Help Your Child Be an Early Learner!

1. **Play games** with your child.
2. **Read and listen** to eBooks with your child – and print books, too!
3. **Talk to your child.** Ask questions. Point out what you like or find funny. Discuss what he learned.
4. **Sing songs and dance** with your child. Create song and dance routines or make it up as you go along!
5. **Encourage learning anywhere and with anyone** – outside the home and with other children.
6. **Make time for technology-free play.** Put away devices at certain times. Set limits on how often technology is used.
7. **Help your child be present and mindful.** Use one resource at time and finish before a new activity is started.
8. **Look for parent support tools** in the resources. Learning more about them will help you help your child.
9. **Communicate what you know.** Your child might know a lot about how to use the resources, but you know more about when and why to use the resource.
10. **Trust your judgment.** You know best about what resources are appropriate for your child’s maturity, knowledge, and behavior.
